Tri- Block Squares Quilt

Blocks – ½ yard of 3 contrasting fabrics for top

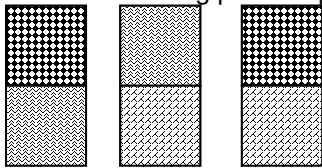
Border – (5) – 4" strips for border

Backing – 1 ½ yards or 42/44" x 66" [with optional borders, backing must be 44" wide]

Batting – 45" x 60"

Cut 4 strips of 3 different fabrics 4 ½" x wof*.

Sew the following pairs strips.



Cut paired sewn strips sets into (24) 4 ½" segments.

Cut (24) 4 ½" x 8 ½" segments, separate into 3 separate stacks. Place a third fabric stack next to sewn two-patch stacks.

Sew a 4 ½" x 8 ½" to the two patch, keeping the fabrics in the same order.

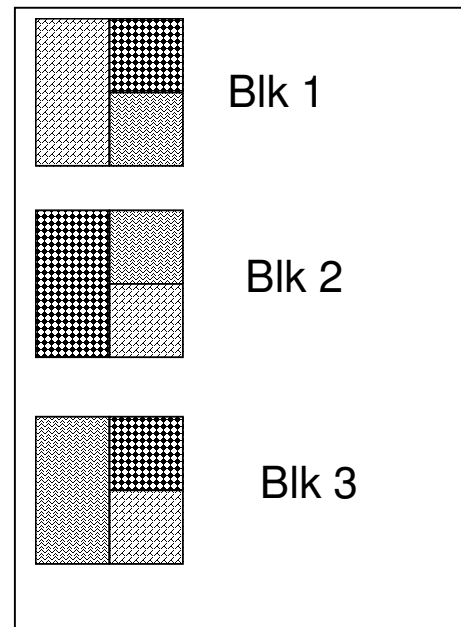
Make (8) of Block 1, Block 2, and Block 3

Arrange in a pleasing manner: 4 across x 6 down.

Add Border strips

Quilt and Bind.

Finished size 39 x 55



Helpful Hint: use colored pencils to shade in blocks.

* WOF - Width Of Fabric approximately 42-44" wide.
