2019 QUILT SHOW ENTRY FORM CHECKLIST

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE 12/1/2018

Entry Form:

1. Membership dues must be current as of January 18, 2019 and you must have been a continuous member during 2018. No exceptions for member entry fee to apply.
2. \$10.00 non-refundable entry fee (per item) for guild members (\$35 for non-guild members) and picture of entry attached to the Quilt Show Entry Form
3. Be sure the exact size of your entry is written on the Quilt Show Entry Form
Width---size measured in direction of sleeve
Length---vertical hanging measurement
4. Sign "Hold Harmless Agreement"
5. Entry Form must be turned in on or before **January 16, 2019** to:

No late entries will be accepted. As long as your item is able to be photographed and the dimensions provided accurately, you may turn in an entry form even if your quilt isn't completed.

Quilt Turn-In:

1. 4" finished sleeve on back of ALL quilts & wall hangings except Category 2900. Miniatures may have narrower sleeve. Fast-finish triangles will NOT be accepted. See guild website for "How to Make a Sleeve"
2. Name on back of quilt, covered with a loosely basted muslin flap
3. Entry in a CLOTH BAG with your name, and the name of the quilt on the outside and a clear "pocket" with photo of the quilt inserted. Photo pocket needs to be closed and securely attached to the bag.
4. Turn in quilts on February 16, 2019 to Kris Hoffman, 17910 Oak Park Bend Lane, Cypress, TX 77433

Insurance:

All entries will be insured by **West Houston Quilter's Guild** up to a value of \$300. Entries valued at greater than \$300 must have a copy of an appraisal certificate attached to entry form at time of submission. You may contact one of the two appraisers listed below and arrange for this prior to turning in your entry form.

APPRAISALS: Jane Hancock, certified quilt appraiser, will be available at quilt judging if you wish to have your quilt appraised at that time. Please add \$60 to your entry fee for each quilt to be appraised. **Appraisals will be mailed to the entrant sometime after the end of the show.**
